1. About Us

Tangle Teezer Ltd is a company registered in England and Wales with company number 05396577 (referred to as "Tangle Teezer", "we", "us" or "our" in this Cookie Notice). Please see our Privacy Notice for further information on the personal data that we process through your use of our website.

This Cookie Notice sets out to provide information on cookies and similar technologies ("Cookies") used on this website.

2. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text-based files that are stored on your device's browser, with the purpose to facilitate your navigation and purchasing of Tangle Teezer products via our website.

3. How Do We Use Cookies?

Our website may place and access certain first-party Cookies on your computer or device. First-party Cookies are those placed directly by us and are used only by us, or organisations working for us. We use Cookies to facilitate and improve your experience of our website and to provide and improve our products or services.

We also use third party cookies, placed by other organisations. These are explained in section 3 below. Before non-essential Cookies are placed on your computer or device, you will be shown a message requesting your consent to set those Cookies, where you will have the option to set your Cookie preferences by either allowing all Cookies to be placed, allowing the selection you have opted for or deny placement of any non-essential Cookies. By giving your consent to the placing of Cookies you are enabling us to provide the best possible experience and service to you. You may, if you wish, deny consent to the placing of Cookies; however, certain features of our website may not function fully or as intended. You will be given the opportunity to configure your cookie preferences when you visit our webpage.

4. What Categories of Cookies Do We Use?

The cookies we use on our website fall within one of the following categories listed below. When you visit our site, you will be able to "Allow All" Cookies to be placed during your visit; alternatively, you will be able to "Allow Selection" or "Deny" the placement of non-essential Cookies. During your visit, you will be able to change your Cookie setting at any time by visiting "Cookie Preferences" at the bottom of the page.

4.1 Necessary Cookies

These Cookies help make a website usable by enabling basic function like page navigation and access to secure areas of the website and do not require consent. If these Cookies were to be disabled this may affect your user experience, as some of the website functionality may be lost. One example for the use of these Cookies is to enable you to put selected items into your online shopping basket.

The following Cookies can be enabled or disabled upon landing on our website or you can update your preference any time if you visit the "Cookie Preferences" link at the bottom of any page you are on.

4.2 Preference Cookies

Preference Cookies enable a website to remember information that changes the way the website behaves or looks, like your preferred language or the region that you are in. By enabling Preference Cookies, you will be able to see certain features on our site that aren't essential to its running but still adds significant value to you, such as product reviews.

4.3 Statistics Cookies

These Cookies help us to understand how visitors interact with our websites by collecting and reporting information anonymously. This helps us to improve the way our website works and ensures you are able to find what you are looking for.

4.4 Marketing Cookies

These Cookies are used to track visitors across our website, and are shared with third-party advertisers and publishers, with the intention to display ads that are relevant and engaging for the individual users.

4.5 Unclassified Cookies

Unclassified Cookies are those Cookies that we are in the process of classifying, together with the providers of individual Cookies.

5. **Third-Party Cookies**

By using our website, you may also receive certain third-party Cookies on your computer or device, but only when you have consented to them. Third party Cookies are those placed by websites, services, and/or parties other than us and collects user data for the third-party which we may not always have control over.
